

Combination Safe Boating & Personal Watercraft

2 formats - choose the course that best fits your schedule!

Three Week Nights:

This Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) course is taught by volunteer professionals from the Connecticut DEP Boating Division. Upon successfully completing this course and the final examination, students receive a diploma. Submit the course diploma, Application for Certificate, and the appropriate fee to a DEP office to obtain the Connecticut Basic Boating and Personal Watercraft Certificate. This certificate will allow you to operate a motor vessel, including personal water craft (Jet Ski type boats), in the State of Connecticut. Students must attend all three nights to qualify. Please bring a pen or pencil to class. Choose the course that best fits your schedule!

One Day: meets on a Saturday

This course is approved by Connecticut, NASBLA, and is recognized by the U.S. Coast Guard. The easy to understand classroom format is recommended for students age 12 and up. Instruction is through slides with accompanying material that is supplied by the instructor. Topics include: choosing the right boat, equipment requirements, CT boating laws and regulations, safety regulations, navigation rules, buoy systems, trailering, safe fueling, weather, accident prevention, special topics and much more! Upon successful completion of this one day, 8-hour course, and final exam, students can obtain the Connecticut Basic Boating and Personal Watercraft certificate which enables them to operate any motorized recreational vessel up to 65 feet in length, including Jet Ski style vessels, as well as sailboats 19 1/2' in length or longer. Students can either mail or hand deliver the course diploma, Application for Certificate, and the appropriate fee to a DEP office. Please bring a pen or pencil to class.
