**Course Title: Drawing I**

**Course #: Art 111**

**Course Description**

Introduction to drawing concepts, principles, processes, and materials. Topics include gesture, line quality, perspective, value, space, volume, and composition. (3 credits)

**Pre-requisite/Co-requisite: none**

**Goal:** To develop basic drawing skills and apply drawing concepts

**Outcomes:**

- To understand and control line and value as a means of exploring the drawing surface and creating the illusion of three dimensional space, form and volume
- To develop perceptual acuity
- To identify the elements of drawing and apply this vocabulary to interpret and analyze a drawing or painting
- To apply spatial concepts to drawing problems
- To explore various media and methods of composition
