Course Title: Sculpture I

Course #: ART 131

Course Description:

An introductory course in sculpture. Instruction in additive and subtractive methods. Studio activity will include the modeling of figures in clay. (3 credits, 6 studio hours)

Pre-requisite/Co-requisite: None

Goals:

- To develop basic sculpture skills
- To explore the expressive potential of sculpture

Outcomes:

- To create three dimensional forms using additive and subtractive sculptural methods
- To observe and model forms from nature
- To experiment with clay and other sculptural materials and recognize their distinctive properties
- To use the vocabulary of sculpture – plane, mass, volume, texture, light, color, context, material – to express personal content
- To gain exposure to works of historical and contemporary sculpture
- To document/present a portfolio of sculptural works with commentary
